

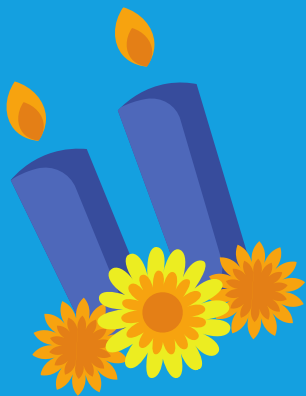

Encendemos velas.



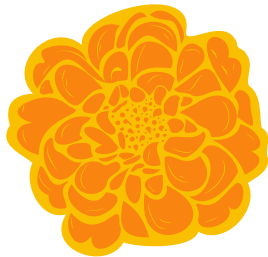
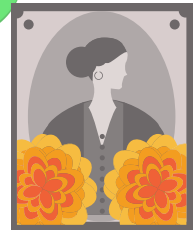
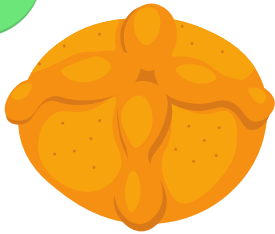
We light candles (las velas).
